# NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM - PARCC

- ❖ 2017 marks the 3rd administration of the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC).
- ❖ Students took PARCC English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 – 11.
- ❖ Students took PARCC Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 – 8 and End of Course Assessments in Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II.
- ❖ PARCC is now a graduation requirement for the Class of 2020 and beyond.

- ❖ Level 1: Not yet meeting grade-level expectations
- ❖ Level 2: Partially meeting grade-level expectations
- ❖ Level 3: Approaching grade-level expectations

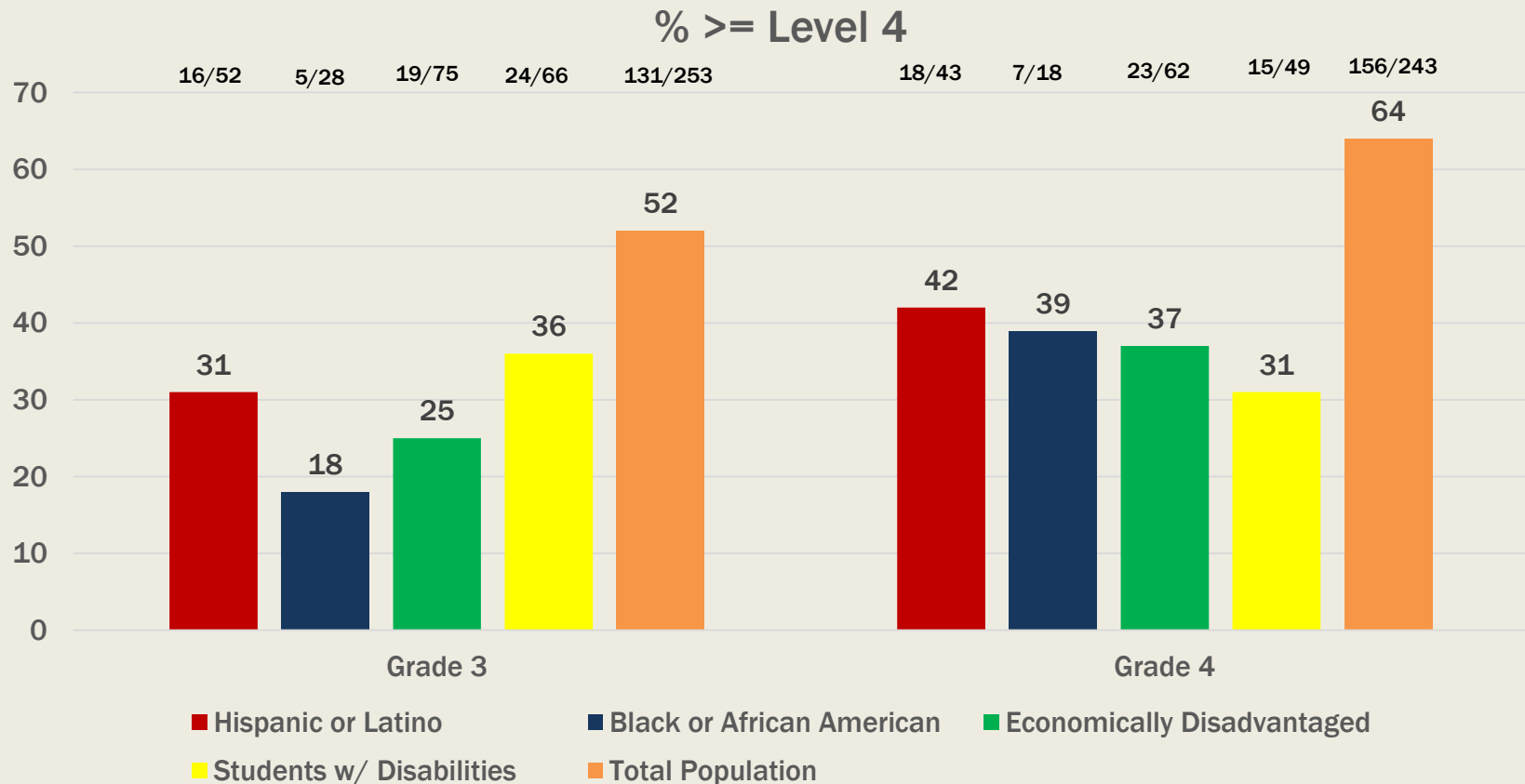

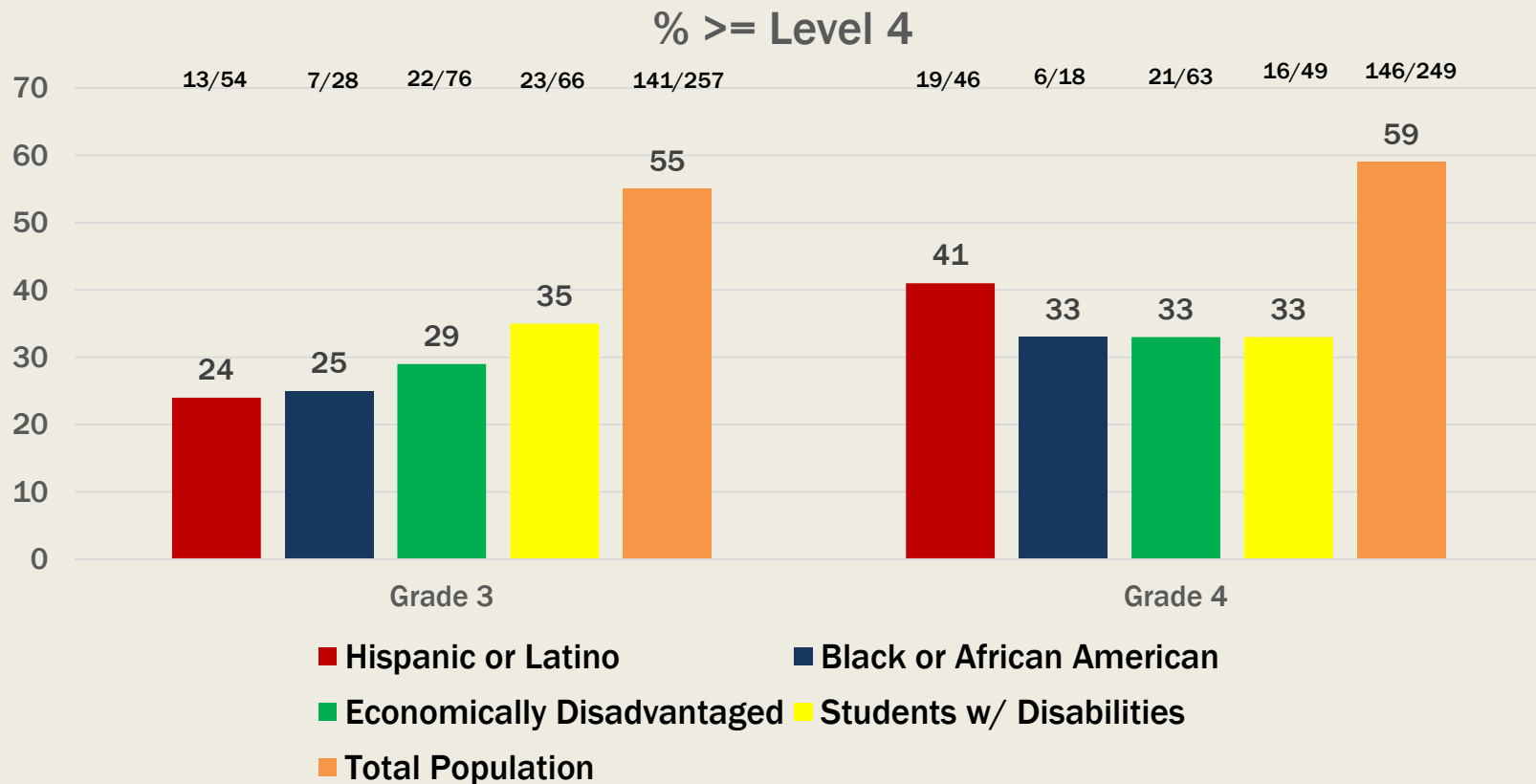

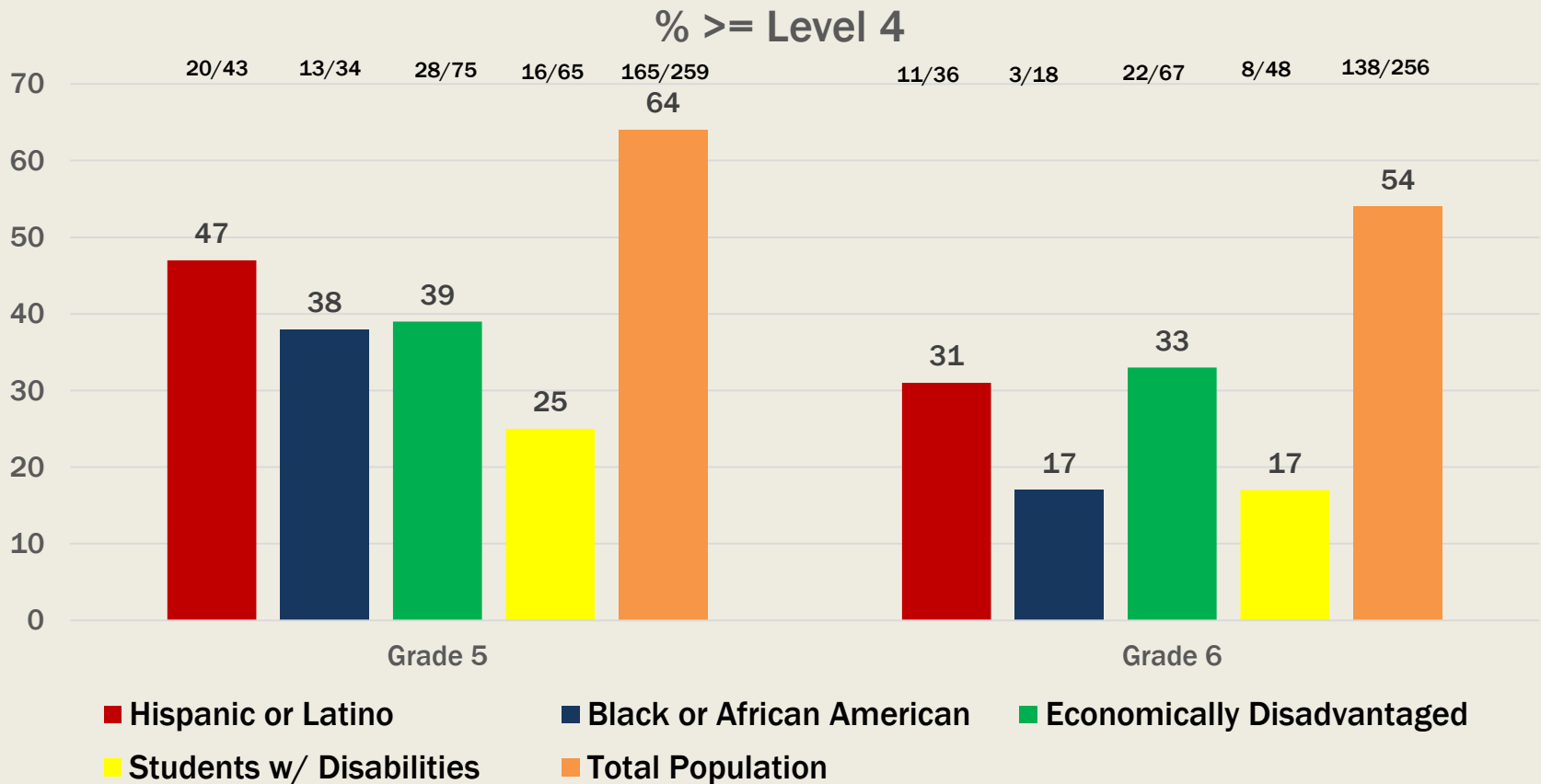

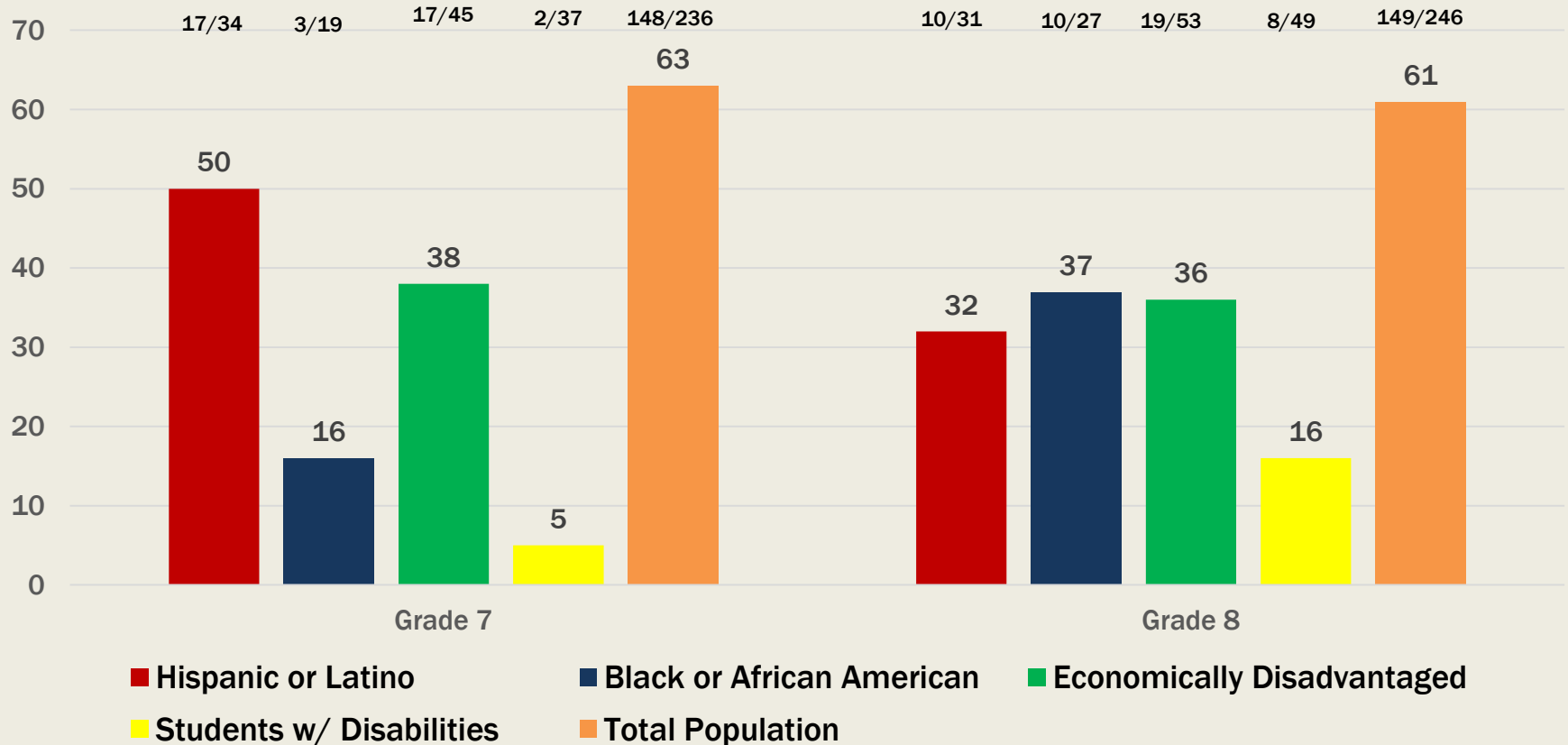

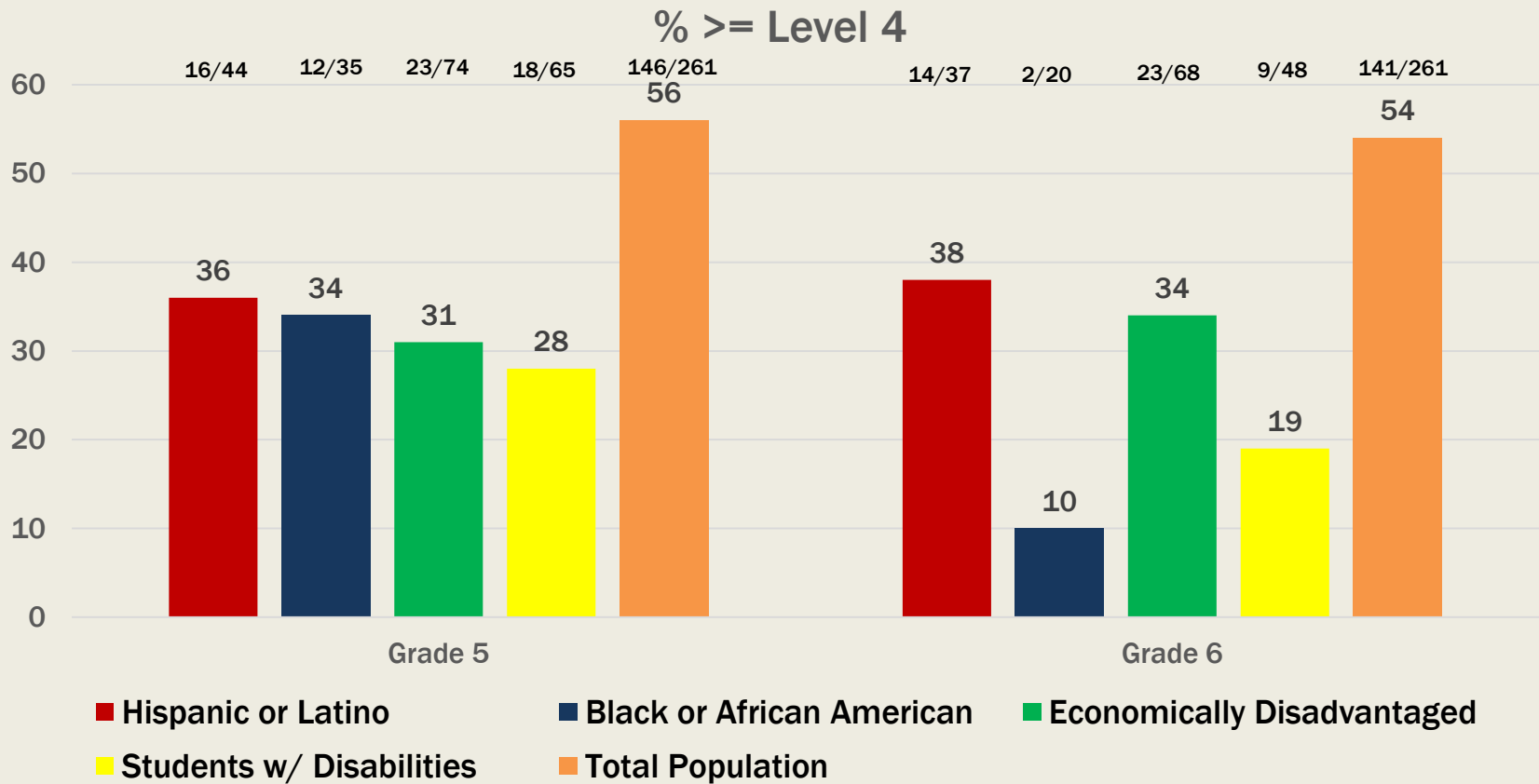

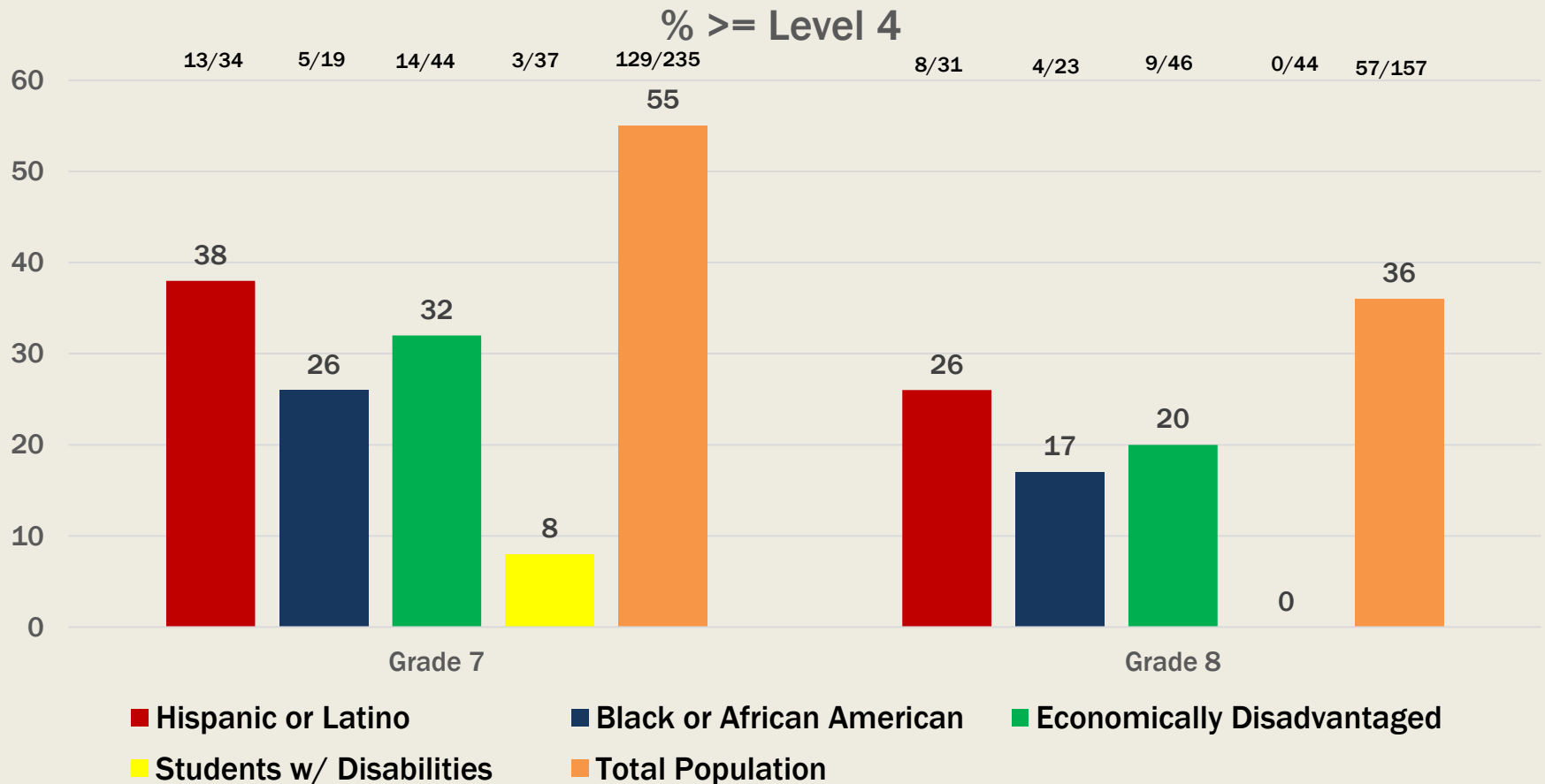

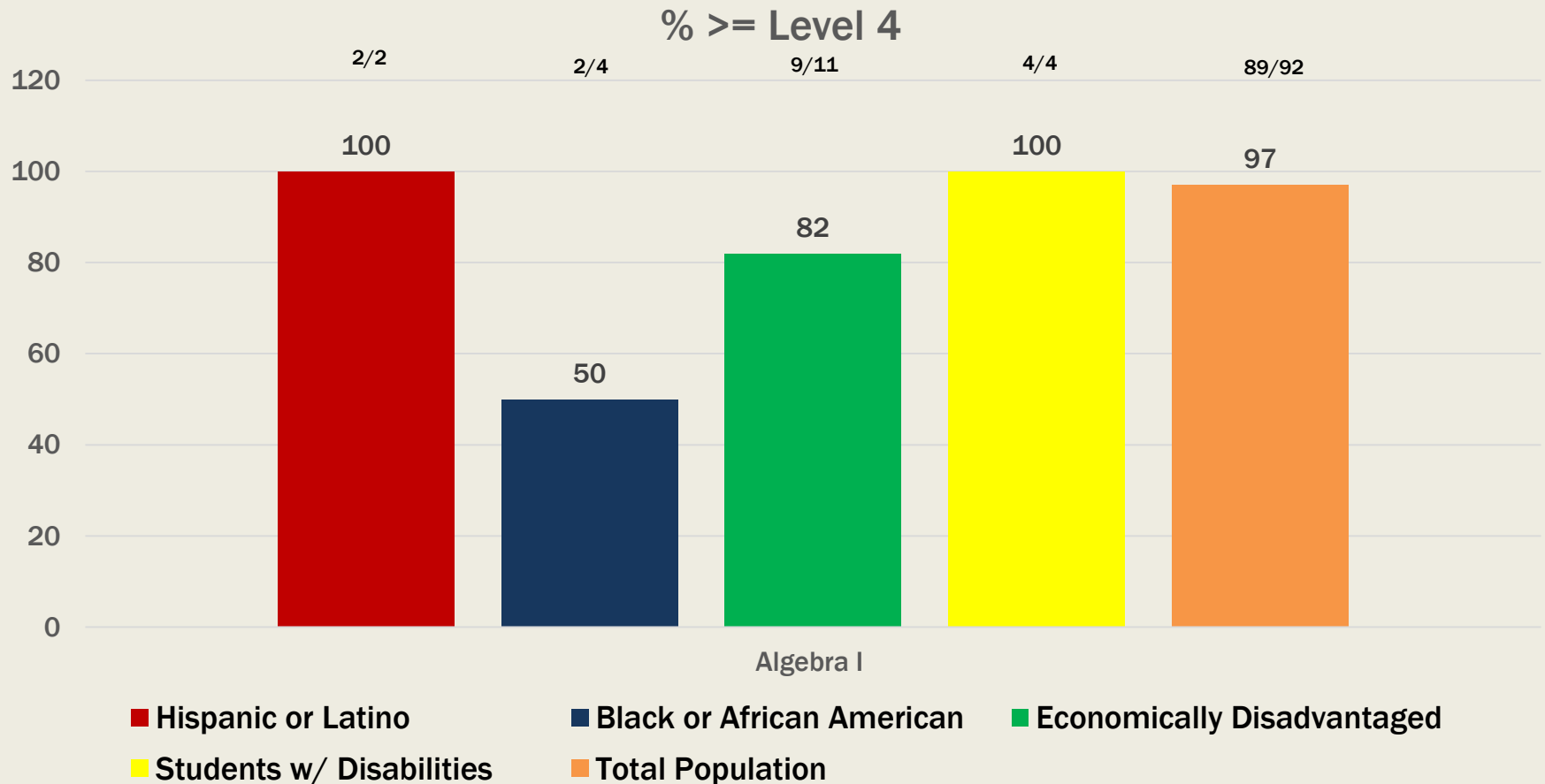
# 2017 SPRING PARCC GRADE 5 & 6 SUB GROUP OUTCOMES MATHEMATICS

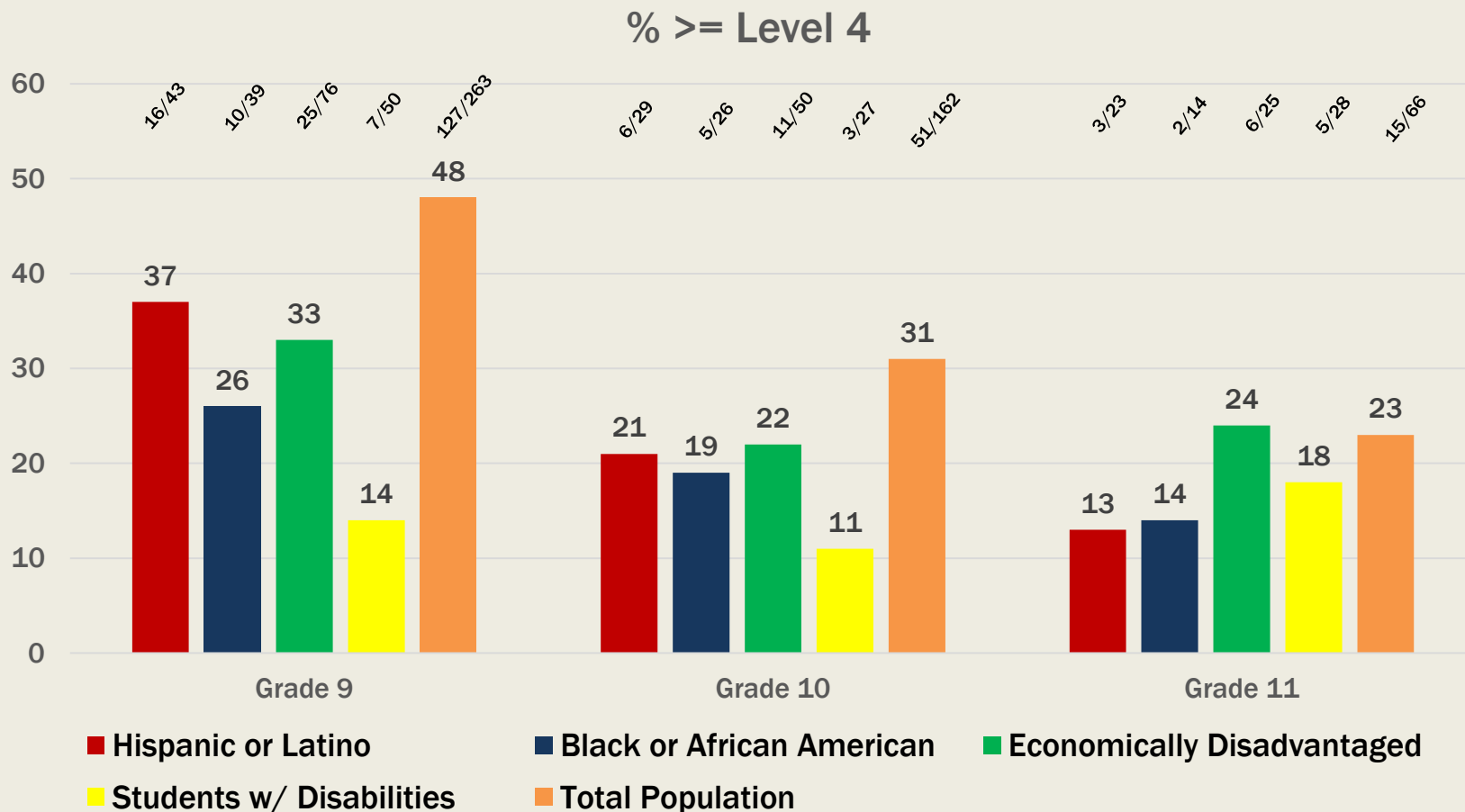

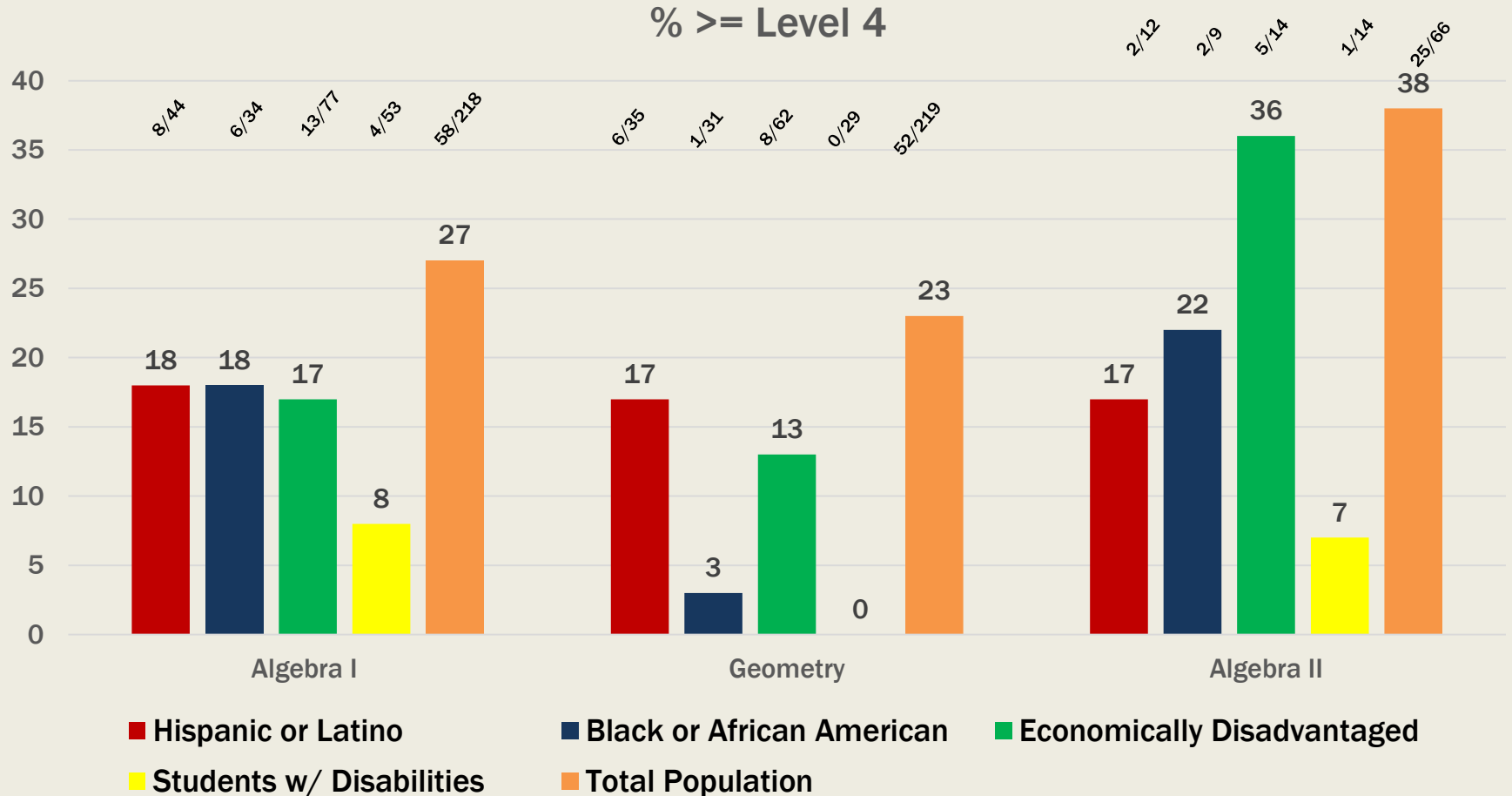

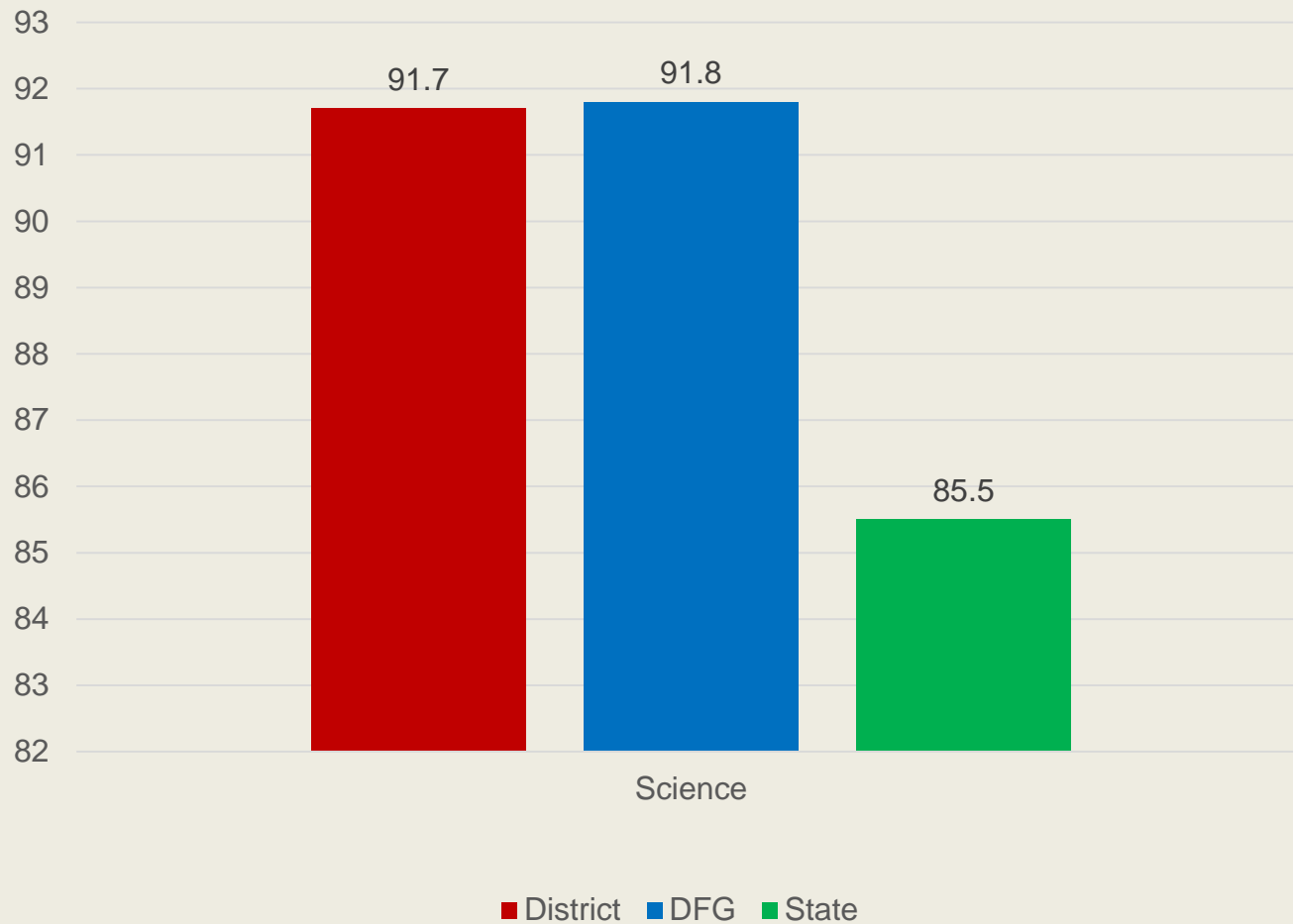

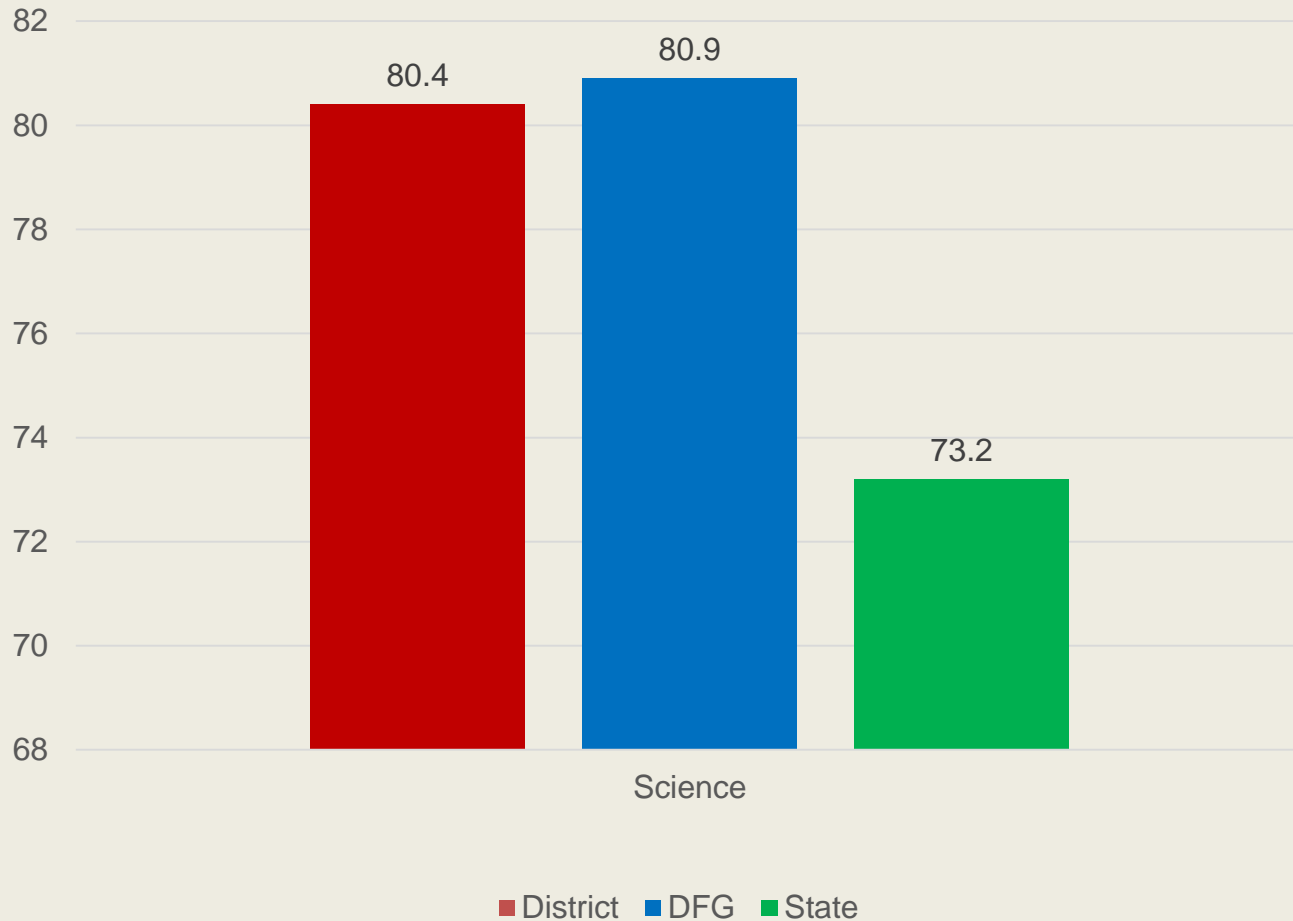


# 2017 NJASK 4 Science Comparison of District, DFG, and State Passing Percentages





# 2017 NJASK 8 Science Comparison of District, DFG, and State Passing Percentages



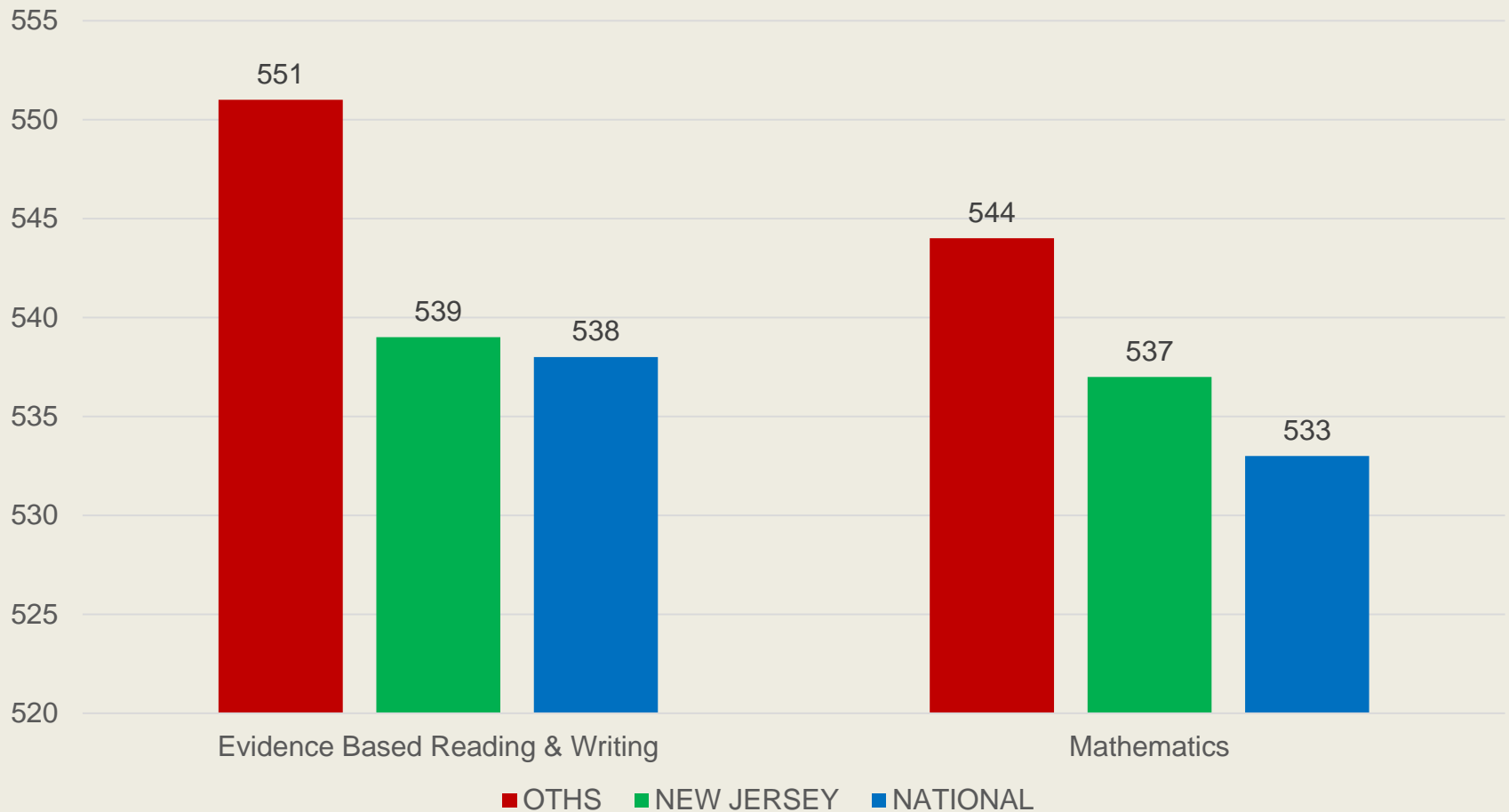
